For the final 2 marking periods you will create a Boring Diagram Explanation Video based on a model that was taken from a previous Regents exam. You will need to determine what phenomena the model is representing and then create a video and completed diagram sheet to share with the other students in our classes. You will be graded based on the content of your video, the scientific accuracy of the video, the clarity and quality of your submitted diagram sheet, and your ability to complete the activity on time.

Requirements

- Video must not exceed 15 minutes in length. (5 - 10 minutes suggested)
- Do not include your full name or any personal information in the video.
- You must write the Main concept / Phenomena on the top of your diagram.
- Only the diagram sheet and your hands can be viewed in the video.
- Video must be submitted as an .mp4 or a .mov file format.
- Your diagram should have your name, period, and student number on the back.
